### Romans Chapters 10 & 11 Review & Use

Before we begin our examination of Romans Chapter 12, we pause today for a "Review and Use" Sunday.

#### REVIEW

#### Six Central Truths and Summary Statements from Romans Chapters 10 & 11

*From Romans 10:1-13*

*Jesus is the fulfillment of law. **He accomplished everything necessary for our righteous standing before God—which comes through faith alone!***

*From Romans 10:14-21*

*Though we know many will reject the Gospel, its beauty remains on display in the life of Christ (and His followers). **We never stop sharing Christ's beauty, though more reject Him than appeal to Him.***

*From Romans 11:1-12*

***While the majority of ethnic Jews remain in unbelief, the gentiles have responded more enthusiastically to salvation through faith in Christ.** God's plans and promises for Jew and Gentile will not fail.*

*From Romans 11:7-10*

*Like Israel, Christians today can fall into the same trap of false confidence. If our place of security is anything other than Jesus, we run the risk of hardened hearts.*

*From Romans 11:13-24*

***Gentiles must continue in humble faith in Christ lest they repeat the arrogant model of ethnic Israel.** Though Jews and gentiles occupy unique roles in God's fulfillment of His promises, they share in these promises by the same means – by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone.*

*From Romans 11:25-36*

*God's faithfulness can always be trusted. **The fullness of Gentiles coupled with corporate Israel being saved ushers in the return of Christ to set up His kingdom which leads to outbursts of praise!***

*All of this points to the unshakable reliability of God to remain faithful to his character, rescue his people and fulfill his purposes & promises.*

**NOTE: Justification:** Declaration of right standing with God.

*Justification does not make us righteous, but rather pronounces us righteous by God, once for all. Legal term –describes our position before God.*

*Our righteousness comes from placing our faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ. This meets God's demands for justice; thus, He declares us righteous—He justifies us. Salvation comes by grace alone; through faith alone; in Christ alone.*
